

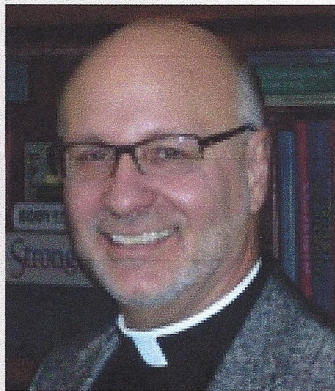

Father Berinti, C.Pp.S., first felt a calling to the priesthood at age 5 and from that time on he never seriously considered anything else. At age 13 he entered high school seminary in Canton, Ohio, and was ordained June 22, 1985, at the Chapel of the Assumption at the St. Charles Center, Carthagen, Ohio, by Bishop James Garland. A member of the Missionaries of the Most Precious Blood religious order, Fr. Berinti currently serves in the Diocese of Orlando, FL, on the pastoral staff of the San Pedro Spiritual Development Center. Prior to moving to Florida, Fr. Berinti spent the first 12 years of his priesthood in ministry to higher education as a professor of religious studies and humanities, campus chaplain, and residence hall mentor, serving at St. Joseph's College, Rensselaer, IN, and Saint Xavier University, Chicago, IL. Before beginning ministry at San Pedro, Fr. Berinti served as pastor of two diocesan parishes, Saint Andrew in Orlando and the Church of the Nativity in Longwood. Fr. Berinti holds an undergraduate degree in English literature, a Master of Divinity from Catholic Theological Union at Chicago, and a Doctorate in Ministry from Boston University School of Theology.
